As many of you know, I began teaching an "Evangelism" Class about three weeks ago during the Discipleship Training hour. I appreciate those who have attended. If you have not been with us and are not currently in another DT Class, we would love for you to come and learn with us. With that being said, it is obvious that evangelism has been on the forefront of my mind for quite some time. As believers, we must desire to see others come to know Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Savior. If I may, I would like to share a little encouragement with you.

2 Thess. 3:1-5, "Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified, even as it is with you: (2) And that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men: for all men have not faith. (3) But the Lord is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep you from evil. (4) And we have confidence in the Lord touching you, that ye both do and will do the things which we command you. (5) And the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God, and into the patient waiting for Christ." A sequence of responsibilities is logical. Learning and living must go together. If we believe the truth, it changes our lives. We guard the truth and practice it so that we can share it with others. Pay attention to this next line: "We cannot share what we do not believe, and we can best share that which we have practiced ourselves." God's Word is alive; we must let it move freely. As we practice the truth and pray for the ministry of the truth, God's Word will have freedom to run and accomplish God's purposes in the world.

Too much Christian work these days is accomplished by human plans and promotion, and not by the Word of God. We trust our programs more than the Word of God. The universe was created, and is sustained, by the Word of God. One individual says it this way, regarding Christian pastors, "It is their task to feed the sheep- not to entertain the goats." As we think about evangelism and what that means for the local church, there are three things we see when the Word of God is at the forefront. When the sheep are fed, they will flock together in love, reproduce, follow the shepherd- and they can be "fleeced" and will love it. It is when the sheep are hungry that they start biting each other, becoming sick, and wandering away. When the Word of God does the work, then God gets the glory.

Don't be mistaken, there is always opposition to the Word of God. Paul asked his friends to pray that he might be delivered from unbelieving men who were evil and wicked. Just as the Spirit uses dedicated people to share the Word, Satan uses wicked people to oppose the Word. Get this... the evil one enjoys using Christian believers to oppose the work of God. As believers, we must be unified through the sealing of the Spirit and the guidance of the Word. Once we are unified, we must be willing to pray for one another as we share the Good News. Are you willing to pray for your fellow believers or are you too busy "biting"?

In the story of the Red Sea, the Israelites followed the pillar of cloud and fire as carefully as possible, thrilled with their new freedom, full of excitement about the future. Yet as they followed Him, God deliberately led them into a cul-de-sac between hostile hills, to the edge of a sea too deep to be forded and too wide to be crossed.

The unmistakable implication of Exodus 14:1-4 is that the Lord took responsibility for leading them into peril. He gave them specific, step-by-step instructions, leading them down a route to apparent ruin: Turn and camp, right there before the entrapping sea. The Lord occasionally does the same with us, testing our faith, leading us into hardship, teaching us wisdom, showing us His ways. Our first reaction may be a surge of panic and a sense of alarm, but we learn to consult the Scriptures for guidance.

So, take a deep breath and recall this deeper secret of the Christian life: when you are in a difficult place, realize that the Lord either placed you there or allowed you to be there, for reasons perhaps known for now only to Himself.

The same God who led you in will lead you out.
