Ready or not, we have entered the holiday season! Are you ready? I know that many of you have big plans for the next couple of months. I hope that you have a great time with your family. I pray that if you are traveling, you have safe travels. Before I begin sharing what is on my heart, I would like to say, "Thank you" for your support during the month of October. As you know, October is Pastor Appreciation Month, and I appreciate your willingness to give financially to the offering. It does not go unnoticed, and I want to say, "Thank you!"

"Praise God from whom all blessings flow." We know this as our Doxology, and we have sung it many, many times. As you study the Book of Psalms, you will find that the "Royal Psalms" are known for Chapters 93, 95-100. These Psalms emphasize God's sovereign rule, His goodness to His people, the responsibility to all nations to acknowledge Him, and the importance of God's people exalting and worshipping Him. As you study Psalm 100, you find three important subject matters: Joy, Submission, and Thankfulness. When we study "Joy," we see that worship leads to serving and true service is worship. If we sing in the Spirit and with understanding, our songs are received in heaven as sacrifices to the Lord (Heb. 13). In Ps. 100:3, the word "know" means "to know by experience." When we truly understand submission, we open our heart to the will of God. Once we open our hearts to the will of God, we openly confess to others and bear witness to our great God. Also, Ps. 100:3 is a simple statement of faith: Jehovah is God, Creator, Redeemer, and Shepherd, and we are submitted to Him! Once we understand Joy and Submission, we can experience Thankfulness. "Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name. (5) For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; And his truth endureth to all generations" Ps. 100:4-5. The procession of worshippers has now reached the gates of the sanctuary, and they burst out in songs of praise. Why? Because of the Lord's goodness, mercy (lovingkindness), and faithfulness. If we are controlled by the Holy Spirit of God and the holy Word of God, we will reveal it in the way we worship God. Instead of imitating the world, we will be led by the Word and the Spirit to be joyful in the Lord, submissive to the Lord, and thankful to the Lord. Also, the spirit of thanksgiving helps us overcome some of the "sins in good standing" that too often invade our lives: complaining (Vs. 1), idolatry (Vs. 2), pride (Vs. 3), and in gratitude (Vs. 4). It was when our first parents became "unthankful" that the human race began that terrible descent into sin and judgement. Instead of being thankful for what they had, Adam and Eve believed Satan's lie that the Lord was holding out on them, and this led to their own sin. Let me remind you of something very important... "A thankful spirit is a triumphant spirit." Do you possess the spirit of Thanksgiving?

I hope you have a great Thanksgiving! I pray that you are thankful for God's provisions on your life! Happy Thanksgiving!




