**1. The Anatomy of the Call (Jer. 1:5-10)**

- a. The **Calling** of Jeremiah (Jer. 1:5)
  - i. God's sonogram did not reveal **tissue** but a **person**, a person who was called for a specific purpose.
  - ii. There are three verbs here in **Jer. 1:5**: God **knew** him, consecrated him, and **appointed** him.
- b. The Possibility of **Objection** (Jer. 1:6)
- c. God's **Response** to Our Reasons (Jer. 1:7-10)
  - i. God **Commands** (Vs. 7)
  - ii. God **Cares** (Vs. 8)
    - 1. Courage is not an act of **character**; it is an act of **faith**.
    - 2. True courage has an **object**: **faith** in the character of God.
  - iii. God **Commissions** (Vss. 9-10)

**2. What Does This Mean for Jeremiah? (Jer. 1:11-19)**

- a. A **Promise**: God will Honor His Word (Jer. 1:11-12)
  - i. If we called to be holy, then **Ministry** is a call to act **Holy**.
- b. A **Prediction**: Disaster is Coming (Jer. 1:13-16)

**Conclusion:**

- The question is not **Calling**; it is **Obedience**.

➤ Obedience is a God-sized **Risk** for a God-sized **Call**.
