Introduction:

- The God who committed <u>never</u> to leave us is the same God who committed never to <u>leave</u> us in sin.
- 1. The Anatomy of Divorce (Jer. 3:8)
 - a. A. We Forget What God Has Done for Us (Jer. 2:5-8)
 - i. If the Word of God is not **prominent** in people's minds, they **forget** that God has decided to relate to people through His Word.
 - ii. The blessed person is the one who obeys God's instruction.
 - iii. Neglecting the Word is not the end of the church. It is the beginning of the end.
- 2. We Find Our Satisfaction in Something Else
 - **a.** Leaders who do not **represent** God's Word to God's people are facilitators of ultimate **separation** between God and His people.
- 3. God Files for Divorce (Jer. 3:8)
 - **a.** God wants a **Divorce**, but even though He wants it, He will not get it.
- 4. God Will Not Leave Us Alone (Jer. 3:1-5)
 - **a.** Why can God not divorce Israel?
 - i. He made a **covenant** to always be with them.
 - ii. If He divorced them, He is bound by His own law and could not "remarry" them.

Conclusion:

When we see our only sustenance is God, we will see that He is all we need to begin with.
