About a month ago, Bro. Jon began teaching a Men's Discipleship Training Class. He is using Dr. Tony Evans' Book "Kingdom Man," and it has been a blessing, for me, to gather with men of all ages and study the Word together. I don't know about the others in the class, but it sure has done my soul good to be in there with them. One of the lessons, about two weeks ago, really stuck with me. I would like to share the theme of the lesson with you in hopes that it will encourage you like it did me

If you know the history of Flowood Baptist Church, there have been some great pastors, who have led this flock of believers. For that, I am grateful. However, there comes a time that we must look to the future and not focus on the past. In the Book of Joshua, it begins with Joshua taking the "torch" from Moses (since he had died) and leading the people into the Promised Land. Joshua was commissioned to lead the new generation into a new challenge: entering and conquering the Promised Land. It was God who had chosen Joshua, and everybody in Israel knew that he was their new leader. We may not agree with the leader all of the time, but we must be willing to submit to the one God has chosen. Joshua, as I have tried to do, did not abandon the past but built on it as he moved forward to the future. God's gift for you and for me is our future not our past.

We are entering into our second month of 2025, and by now most of you have heard how great 2024 was for our church. It was a year that I think we will remember for a long, long time. However, we must be willing to focus on the future. Many of us would agree that we desire to see Flowood Baptist Church continue to grow! The issue for many of us is being willing to do our part. We must be willing to take the first step to follow the Lord's will and direction for our lives. Just like in Joshua's time, before God could fulfill His promises, Joshua had to exercise faith. Josh 1:6, "Be strong and of good courage..." Divine sovereignty is not a substitute for human responsibility. God's sovereign Word is an encouragement to God's servants to believe God and obey His commands. I like the way that Spurgeon said it, "Joshua was not to use the promise as a couch upon which his indolence might luxuriate, but as a girdle wherewith to gird up his loins for future society." In short, God's promises are prods, not pillows. Let that sink in for just a moment. The promises of God are to motivate us. The promises should guide and direct us in our everyday life, for His glory and His honor. So many times, we like to "Rest" in the promises of God, and let me be clear, that is not wrong. However, sometimes the promises of God are to motivate us to continue to move toward our future.

The point? I pray that we as Flowood Baptist Church are thanking God for yesterday's blessing but are continuing to look forward to tomorrow's future. I believe the Lord will provide all that we need in regard to building a new building and an additional parking lot. However, I believe that we must be willing to do our part. The Bible commissioned us to "Go" just like it commissioned Joshua to lead. Are you willing to go? Are you willing to share the Good News of Jesus Christ? May I challenge you to accept the promises of God as a prod, not just a pillow. Step out in faith, seek His will, and allow your faith to become alive and real!
