"The Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many." (Matthew 20:28)

Such a great verse <u>about</u> our Savior, Jesus Christ.

Person of Christ — "The Son of man came." Both the deity and humanity of Christ are stated here in these words. The deity of Christ is stated in the word "came," for "came" says Christ already had to exist. The pre-existence of Jesus Christ testifies of His deity. The humanity of Christ is seen in the title "Son of man." In coming to earth, Christ humbled Himself and became a man in order to be our Savior.

Purpose of Christ — "To minister." Christ came to earth to minister. Christ did not come primarily to curse, judge, or destroy. His primary purpose was to minister to our soul's need.

Price for Christ — "Give his life." Christ paid the supreme sacrifice to help man. He gave His life that we might have life. The fact that He had to give His life to save us tells us something about the greatness of our sin. We belittle sin and play down its seriousness. But sin is so terrible that it required nothing less than Christ to die for us.

Provision in Christ — "Ransom for sin." Our spiritual debt because of our sin is so great that we cannot pay it ourselves. But Christ provided the ransom for our sin by His death on the cross. His blood, which was shed at Calvary, is the only thing that will pay the ransom. This provision in Christ is available for everyone. However, many folk will die and go to hell for eternity because they have rejected this ransom for their soul.


