The Train Follows the Engine
Trains seem to be fascinating to children. Maybe it is because of their size or power or the noisiness, but it is impressive to stand and watch them, as they pass by all the way from the engine to the caboose. At times, we as kids would count the cars, and we would always try to get the engineer's attention so that they might blow their whistle at us. One thing I learned early on was that regardless of how many cars or what they were carrying; they all were going where the engine was going. The individual cars could not decide to take a right turn at the next crossing or head off down into the woods or down some back road. Why? Well, for one thing, the train's ability to travel and deliver is a system that only works when they are together. Another thing is that they have no power whatsoever on their own. Power is in the engine.

Paul, writing to the church at Corinth in 1 Corinthians 11:1, encouraged people to follow him as he followed Christ. That is a pretty bold statement. The key is not just to follow Paul; the key is for Paul and the entire church to join in following Jesus. To those squabbling saints at Corinth, he sought to help them to understand that their spiritual power and their spiritual achievements would only be found as they unite behind a purpose and in the strength of the living Christ Himself. Paul was not front and center; Jesus was, and as Paul followed Christ, he called on them to help to get the job done. They all, were needed. If Jesus is our leader, it must be understood that He is the engine and I suppose you could include the engineer. We should get behind Him.


